

Executive Order No. 01-2022

Declaration of Local State of Emergency

WHEREAS, the National Weather Service has issued flood warnings along Rock Creek, and

WHEREAS, on Sunday June 12, 2022 record high water was seen on Rock Creek causing wide spread flooding, and

WHEREAS, the flooding has caused severe damage to City infrastructure to include roadways, culverts, bridges, water and sewer mains, and

WHEREAS, these conditions require timely action to minimize the immediate peril to life or property caused by the imminent threat of a disaster, including action in accordance with applicable local and interjurisdictional and emergency plans and programs.


IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, by the Mayor of the City of Red Lodge, that an emergency is hereby declared pursuant to Section 10-3-402, MCA and local disaster is hereby declared pursuant to Section 10-3-403 MCA as the expenditures to repair damaged facilities will be beyond the financial capability of the City of Red Lodge.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that there shall be appropriated immediately to the Disaster Fund in an amount equivalent to two (2) mills on the taxable valuation of the City pursuant to Section 10-3-405 MCA. Said two (2) mills will be levied during fiscal year 2023 and be utilized for restoring services and repairing facilities damaged by flooding.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of this Executive Order be filed with the County Clerk and Recorder, County Assessor, and the Montana Disaster and emergency Services Division in Helena.
