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Red Lodge Carnegie Library Plan for Facility & Grounds Improvements

- Remodel: Kevin Anderson Architects / Kevin Aukema Construction / Adams Trust
 - Still in progress:
 - Office furniture
 - Memorial plaques and artwork (final check from the trust received 2/28/23 will go towards the plaque)
- Roof(s)
 - o Bradford Roofing have completed work on the Koski Addition roof
 - Electrician is needed to reconnect the solar panels and to wire the heated membrane liner in the gutters.
 - o Eventual plan to replace original roof.
 - Structural engineer recommends investigating the internal condition of the trusses in all corners of the addition. Can help with a plan to improve drainage from melting snow on roof when replaced.
- Bathroom updates and Kitchen Remodel
 - o Electrical waiting on fan in public restroom
 - Kitchen remodel on hold until leak points on east wall have been fixed and plan in place for use of the kitchen space.
 - Replace original window in kitchen east wall (estimate from RL Glass)
- Basement Book Sale Room
 - Clean out musty closet
 - Deaccession older furniture (ongoing)
- Façade work (Sweeney Masonry or other)
 - White stains on brick should be done after roof/gutters are replaced
 - Decorative concrete and damaged concrete window sill
- Upgrades to Furnaces/HVAC systems
 - Install HEPA air filters (County ARPA Project Grant) waiting for electronic filter cost to assess remaining budget (\$2100 available)
