**WHEREAS**, the Montana Code Annotated, §13-19-202, authorizes the governing body to request by resolution mail ballot elections; and

**WHEREAS**, the mail ballot election is the most economically and administratively feasible manner of conducting the election; and


**WHEREAS**, the City Council of Red Lodge, Montana supports the use of mail ballot elections;

**NOW BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED** by the City Council of Red Lodge, Montana:


