

RESOLUTION NO. 3459

A RESOLUTION OF THE RED LODGE CITY COUNCIL TO DEDICATE VAN DYKE PARK AS AN OFFICIAL CITY PARK WITH CONTINUED USE AS A PARK FOR OPEN SPACE AND TRAILS

WHEREAS, the Red Lodge City Council resolved on December 12, 2017 to approve the dedication of Van Dyke Park as recommended by the Red Lodge Parks, Trails and Recreation Board; and

WHEREAS, the recommendation by the Red Lodge, Parks, Trails and Recreation Board is to continue the use of the land as an open-space park with trails; and

WHEREAS, The Parks, Trails and Recreation Board unanimously supports making Van Dyke Park a permanent City Park; and

WHEREAS, the City of Red Lodge 2015 Growth Policy, 2015 Comprehensive Parks Plan and 2016 Active Transportation Plan state the need to increase access and recreational opportunities with linear parks; and



1. That Van Dyke be dedicated as an official City park.


