#### **RESOLUTION NO. 3567**

# A RESOLUTION OF INTENT TO ANNUALLY ADJUST THE CITY OF RED LODGE'S WATER AND SEWER RATES AND CHARGES TO BECOME EFFECTIVE ON JULY 1, 2021 AND SETTING A DATE AND TIME FOR A PUBLIC HEARING.

WHEREAS, the water and sanitary sewer rates and charges in effect at the present time are not adequate to provide revenues to defray the increased costs of operation, maintenance, and capital of the City's water and sewer distribution facilities and systems; and

WHEREAS, the City of Red Lodge must ensure that rates, charges and classifications of its water and sewer utilities are reasonable and just in accordance with MCA 69-7-101 and that undertakings are self-supporting in accordance with MCA 7-7-4424; and

WHEREAS, the provision of the water and sewer systems and facilities is essential to the preservation of the public's health and welfare; and, that the new rates, must before taking effect, be approved by the City Council after advertising and conducting a public hearing pursuant to the Rules and Regulations governing Water and Waste Water Service for the City of Red Lodge, Title 10, Chapter 8, Section 1, as previously adopted by the City Council through Ordinance 916 and MCA Section 69-7-111; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 3386 containing the water and sewer rates and charges for the City of Red Lodge for the five-year period July 1, 2015 to June 30, 2020 has aged-out and has not been amended to schedule rates and charges for the next five-year fiscal period July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2025; and

WHEREAS, current budgetary practices with respect to the operations and capital projects of the City's water and sewer enterprises require the proposed rates and adjustment methods to become effective on or about July 1, 2021, thus enabling the City to maintain grant eligibility yearly in conjunction with Resolution 3386 intentions; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Montana law, the City Council has determined that a public hearing must be advertised and held to gather public testimony and input regarding any proposed increases or adjustments to water and sewer rates and charges.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RED LODGE, MONTANA:

- 1. That the City Council of the City of Red Lodge considers it both advisable and necessary to annually adjust the municipal water and sewer rates and charges for all users and proposes to adjust the rates and charges as specifically described within "EXHIBIT A" containing the City's FY 2019-20 rates and charges schedule, the 2020 Montana Consumer Price Index (CPI) and inflation rate, and a sample utility bill. They are attached hereto and hereby incorporated into this Resolution by reference.
- 2. That a public hearing shall be held on May 11<sup>th</sup>, 2021 at 6:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers, at City Hall, Red Lodge, Montana, for the purpose of gathering and receiving testimony, input and comments from all interested or affected users, citizens, persons, associations, corporations and/or companies.
- 3. Notice of the hearing shall be published once a week for three consecutive weeks in the *Carbon County News*, a newspaper that conforms to the requirements of MCA § 7-1-4127, and the first such publication shall not be more than twenty-eight (28) days prior to the hearing and the last publication shall be not less than three (3) days prior to the hearing, in a form substantially similar to the Notice of Public Hearing marked and attached hereto as "Exhibit A".

- 4. Additionally, the notice of the hearing shall be mailed at least seven (7) days and not more than thirty (30) days prior to the hearing to all persons who are served by the City's utilities. The notice shall contain an estimate of the amount the customer's average monthly bill will change.
- 5. A copy of this Resolution and Notice of the Public Hearing (EXHIBIT A) shall be mailed to the Montana Consumer Counsel at least seven (7) days before but not more than thirty (30) days prior to the hearing date.

The table below represents the FY 2021-22 water rates and charges based on FY 2019-20 rates and the 2020 inflation rate (a percentage).

- Curb-stop fees will not be adjusted and
- the inflation rate variable used by the City to update water and sewer rates and charges will not exceed 3% even if the State determines the inflation rate is above 3%.

The City is proposing to modify the existing **sewer rates** annually starting with current fiscal year rates (FY 2019-20) and modifying the rates and charges using the Montana State Consumer Price Index and inflation rate (determined annually). The table below represents the FY 2021-22 sewer rates and charges based on FY 2019-20 rates and the 2020 inflation rate (a percentage).

Fiscal Year (FY) being July 1 - June 30

Each year the City shall follow the same adjustment procedure: current FY rates and charges adjusted using the MT State CPI inflation rate published each February and applied beginning each July 1. As with the water utility, the inflation rate variable used by the City to update water and sewer rates and charges will not exceed 3% even if the State determines the inflation rate is above 3%.

# Other water and sewer charges and fees shall remain unchanged as below:

# **Discontinuance/Re-establishment Charges**

- A. Water Service: Charge for discontinuance/re-establishment of water service Inside normal working hours (when City Hall is open) – Fifty dollars (\$50.00). Outside normal working hours – Seventy-five dollars (\$75.00).
- B. Wastewater Service: Charge for discontinuance/re-establishment of wastewater service: Per hour – Sixty dollars (\$60.00).

2020 State of Montana Consumer Price Index (CPI) inflation rate is 1.2%

If my monthly water, sewer and curbstop fee currently totals \$91.18, my adjusted bill for August 2021 would be \$92.25 (water and sewer are adjusted, but not the curbstop fee).

This adjustment is made by multiplying each current FY 2020-21 rates for water (38.91) and sewer (50.27) by themselves (1) and the annual inflation rate (.012) and then adding the curbstop fee (2.00):

 $\begin{array}{l} 38.91 \ x \ 1.012 = 39.38 \\ 50.27 \ x \ 1.012 = 50.87 \\ \text{curbstop fee} = \ 2.00 \ (\text{no change}) \\ \text{Total} = 92.25 \end{array}$ 

As an example, this residential customer's adjustment amounts to:

\$1.07 additional per month during FY 2021-22
