## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF RED LODGE, MONTANA TO ALLOCATE UP TO \$15,000 OF THE BUDGET TOWARD AN INVESTMENT GRADE AUDIT

- WHEREAS, the City of Red Lodge is entering into a contract with an Energy Service Provider (McKinstry) to conduct an Investment Grade Audit (IGA); AND
- WHEREAS, if the IGA report concludes that the City will not receive enough in savings to pursue and Energy Performance Contract (EPC), then the City must pay McKinstry for services provided; AND
- **WHEREAS,** following the IGA if the City decides to enter into an EPC with McKinstry, the City may choose to roll the IGA costs into the EPC; AND
- WHEREAS, per the Energy Conservation Plan, the City set a goal to reduce carbon emissions 50% by 2040.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,

The City of Red Lodge allocates up to \$15,000 from the budget to pay McKinstry for performing an Investment Grade Audit on municipal-owned facilities.
