

RESOLUTION NO. 3185

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RED LODGE, MONTANA, APPROVING THE CONSTRUCTION OF PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT IN LIONS PARK.

WHEREAS, The City Council for the City of Red Lodge has a written lease agreement with the Lion Club for the maintenance and operation of Lions Park consisting of City owned park land; and

WHEREAS, the City of Red Lodge retained control of what major improvements are made to Lions Park, and the City previously participated in and assisted with funding for playground design and equipment now proposed for Lions Park; and



2. The City Council resolves that upon completion of this playground, the City remove the existing playground equipment and recommend to Lions Club that this area be returned to open park space.
