

**RESOLUTION NO. 3330**

**A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RED LODGE, MONTANA, TO SUBMIT TO THE VOTERS OF RED LODGE THE QUESTION OF EXTENDING THE CURRENT FIRE TRUCK MILL LEVY FOR AN ADDITIONAL TEN YEARS.**

**WHEREAS**, the voters of the City of Red Lodge, in November of 2003, voted to authorize a levy of six (6) mills for ten (10) years for the purchase of a fire truck; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Red Lodge needs to continue to replace fire trucks in order to provide for adequate fire protection and reasonable fire insurance rates; and

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City of Red Lodge requests that the voters authorize in the November 2011 election, a ten (10) year extension of the Fire Truck mill levy of six (6) mills approved in 2003 in order to purchase a replacement fire truck.

Proposition

Shall the voters of the City of Red Lodge authorize a ten (10) year extension of the fire truck mill levy of six (6) mills (which will raise approximately \$38,022) approved in 2003 in order to purchase a replacement fire truck,?

Fiscal Note

The 2005 property tax impact on a home valued at \$100,000 would be approximately \$7.72 and a home valued at \$200,000 would be approximately \$15.43

\_\_\_\_\_ Yes, the City of Red Lodge shall authorize a ten (10) year extension of the fire truck mill levy to purchase a replacement fire truck.

\_\_\_\_\_ No, the City of Red Lodge shall NOT authorize a ten (10) year extension of the fire truck mill to purchase a replacement fire truck.
