

RESOLUTION NO. 3376

A RESOLUTION OF THE RED LODGE CITY COUNCIL TO ADOPT AN OFFICIAL NAME FOR A PARK DEDICATED BY SUBDIVISION LAW

WHEREAS, the City of Red Lodge owns land adjacent to Mountain Springs Villa that has been dedicated for park as part of subdivision law, and

WHEREAS, a request has been received to honor Jim Phillips as the oldest residing tenant of Mountain Springs Villa and his deceased wife Bev, and


WHEREAS, the draft 2014 Red Lodge Comprehensive Parks Plan notes the importance of dedicated undeveloped parks in addressing park deficiencies, and

WHEREAS, the Red Lodge Parks has recommended the naming of this parcel of land as Phillips Park,


